#### ABOUT THE SUGARLOAF PARK

- The Sugarloaf dam is a manmade reservoir supplying water to the greater Melbourne. Comprising of 4.4km<sup>2</sup> and carrying a water capacity of 96 gigalitres.
- ▶ Located in Christmas Hills, 35km north-east of Melbourne.
- Fishing is restricted to signed areas. There is no wading and no natural bait permitted.
- As the signed areas can be difficult to spot on a casual visit this guide with maps should assist fisho's.



#### FISHING RULES

- Strictly fishing within the signed areas only.
- Strictly <u>no wading</u>.
- Strictly no natural baits <u>artificial lures only</u>.
- No berley.



#### FISH TARGET SPECIES

- Brown Trout
- Rainbow Trout
- English Perch (Redfin)
- European Carp
- Roach

\*DPS research suggests mercury levels are higher than safe for human consumption in the reservoir.




#### SUGGESTED TECHNIQUE & TACKLE

- Try to fish the structure logs, trees in the water etc.
- Using soft plastics, spinners, diving or surface lures cast out in a fan around the structure.
- Vary your retrieve. Fish often bite on the lure "drop."
- Crustacean model soft plastics could be cast and left to "soak", twitching the line, with small retrieves to draw attention.
